To Our Residents and Family Members:

On Friday 1/22/2021 we tested all staff and had no positive results for COVID-19. Today 1/26/2021 we again tested all staff and we had no new positive cases. Yesterday 1/25/2021 we tested any resident that has not previously tested positive for COVID-19 and we had no positive cases. We will again test all staff on Friday 1/29/2021. As a result of not having any positive cases of COVID-19 for 14 days, we will not have to test residents unless a resident shows signs and symptoms of COVID-19 or we have another positive staff or resident case in the facility.

We will start having activities again for residents beginning tomorrow 1/27/2021. Residents will be required to wear a mask at the activity and proper hand hygiene will be practiced along with residents being appropriately social distanced. As soon as the CMS county positivity rates have Seneca County below 10% and we have no new positive cases for at least 14 days we will resume inside visitations.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We had our second COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Sunday 1/17/2021. This clinic was the second shot of a two dose series of COVID-19 vaccination and the first shot for people that didn't receive their first dose at our first clinic in December. Our third vaccination clinic will be on Sunday 2/7/2021. At this clinic, residents and staff that have received the first dose of the vaccination but have not yet received the second dose will be receiving the second dose.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
