To Our Residents and Family Members:

Yesterday, 3/23/2021 we tested all staff and had no positive results for COVID-19.

We are currently having activities for residents. Residents are required to wear a mask at the activity and proper hand hygiene is being practiced along with residents being appropriately social distanced. Dining rooms have also been opened up for use. Residents are able to come to the dining room if they wish for meals and sit one resident per table. We also started offering inside visits again. These will continue as long as we don't have any positive cases in the facility. Beautician services are also up and running.

Yesterday the new order was posted with revised indoor visitation guidelines. These changes will allow us to loosen our current indoor visitation guidelines to allow for more visits to take place in the facility. We are working on our policy and process for this change and I will post a letter in the next few days announcing the changes.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
