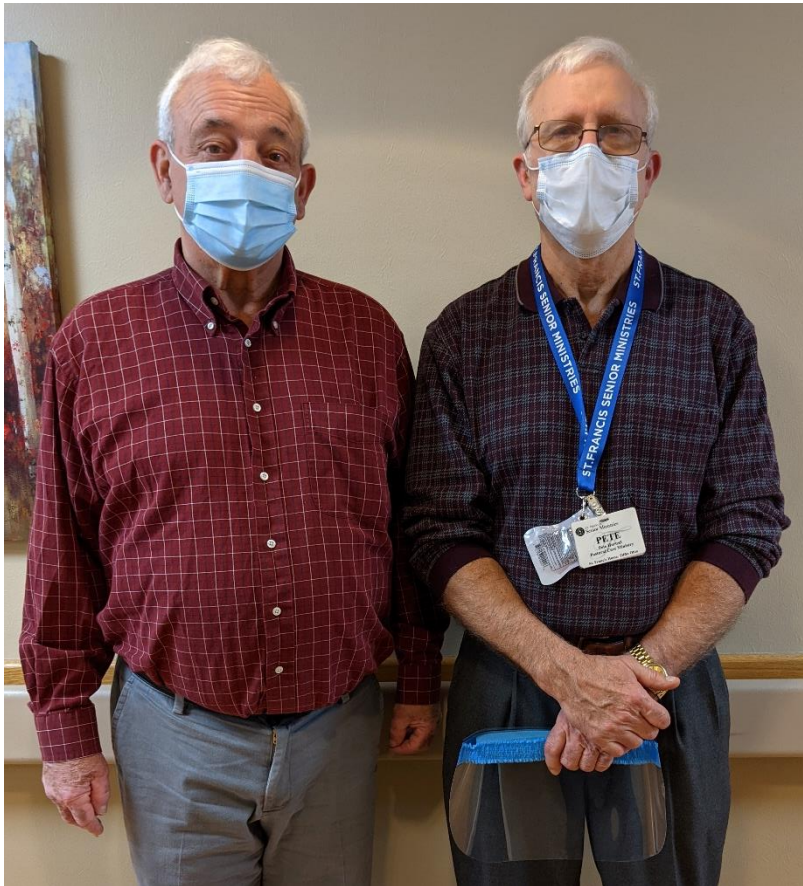


Celebrating the Volunteers at St. Francis Home for the Month of January 😊
