To Our Residents and Family Members:

On Friday 11/13/2020 we conducted COVID-19 testing on all staff. We received the results all of these tests late yesterday and we have had another 3 staff members test positive. All residents were tested again yesterday 11/17/2020 and all residents tested negative for COVID-19. All residents will be tested again on Tuesday 11/24/2020. All staff will continue to be tested every Friday. This Friday 11/20/2020 the testing that will be completed on staff will be the rapid testing so we will have all results on Friday 11/20/2020.

Because of new federal requirements if we receive a positive test we are required to test all residents and staff every 3-7 days until we have no positive cases in the facility. Unfortunately, due to having positive cases we have had to stop our inside visitation. As soon as we are clear of all COVID-19 in the facility for 14 days we will resume visitation. We are now lifting our strict quarantine and beautician services will be able to resume.

We are working with local and state health officials to ensure we are taking all the appropriate steps.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
