To Our Residents and Family Members:

On Friday 1/15/2021 we tested all staff and had no positive results for COVID-19. Today 1/19/2021 we again tested all staff and we had no new positive cases. Yesterday 1/18/2021 we tested any resident that has not previously tested positive for COVID-19 and we had no positive cases. We will again test all staff on Friday 1/22/2021 and residents again on Monday 1/25/2021.

Because of new federal requirements if we receive a positive test we are required to test all residents and staff every 3-7 days until we have no positive cases in the facility. Unfortunately, due to having positive cases we have had to stop our inside visitation. As soon as we are clear of all COVID-19 in the facility for 14 days we will resume visitation. We now have to quarantine all residents to their rooms and stop beautician services at this time.

We are working with local and state health officials to ensure we are taking all the appropriate steps.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We had our second COVID-19 vaccination clinic on Sunday 1/17/2021. This clinic was the second shot of a two dose series of COVID-19 vaccination and the first shot for people that didn't receive their first dose at our first clinic in December. Our third vaccination clinic will be on Sunday 2/7/2021. At this clinic, residents and staff that have received the first dose of the vaccination but have not yet received the second dose will be receiving the second dose.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
