To Our Residents and Family Members:

There have been no additional updates to share since our update last Tuesday.

We are no longer testing staff or residents on a normal basis no matter their vaccination status. We would test a staff member or resident if they had signs and symptoms of COVID or in certain outbreak situations.

As of 10/10/22 the community transmission rates went from high down to substantial so currently staff, residents, and visitors are able to go without wearing masks in the facility. If the community transmission goes back up to a high level we will have to go back to wearing masks. We have this posted throughout the building and the posting also gives recommendations on when particular individuals should wear masks based on close contacts.

We are still asking family members to sign out the resident when they leave and sign them back in when they return at the reception desk. However, family members will no longer have to sign the Negotiated Risk Agreement when taking a resident out.

Since restrictions have been scaled back this will be the last letter that will get posted on a weekly basis unless we were to have a staff member or resident test positive for COVID or there would be a change in guidance that I need to communicate.
