To Our Residents and Family Members:

Yesterday, after our update was sent, we had a staff member in our Chiara unit test positive for COVID. We then had a resident on our 2 East unit test positive for COVID. We will be testing residents and staff in each unit that were identified to have high risk exposure to the resident and staff member that tested positive. These tests will be given day 1, 3, and 5. Any staff member that goes into Chiara or our 2nd floor will now have to wear a mask. Visitors will not be required to wear a mask but will be recommended to wear a mask in those units.

We are still asking family members to sign out the resident when they leave and sign them back in when they return at the reception desk. However, family members will no longer have to sign the Negotiated Risk Agreement when taking a resident out.

We will give updates as we have more to give.
