To Our Residents and Family Members:

After last week's positive cases we have completed all rounds of testing and have not had any more positive cases of COVID. Currently any staff member that goes into Chiara or our 2nd floor will now have to wear a mask. Visitors will not be required to wear a mask but will be recommended to wear a mask in those units.

We are still asking family members to sign out the resident when they leave and sign them back in when they return at the reception desk. However, family members will no longer have to sign the Negotiated Risk Agreement when taking a resident out.

Thanksgiving is coming up in a few weeks and this will be the first time in several years that we have been able to have families come in and eat in the dining room with residents. In order to best prepare for the amount of food that will need to be ordered and prepared for Thanksgiving lunch we are asking families to call into the front desk and reserve their spot by Friday 11/18/2022. All guests and residents would eat in the main dining room on the 1st floor. Due to limited space, we are asking that we limit the number of guests to three per resident unless other arrangements are made with the front desk. Please note this is for Thanksgiving lunch which will be served at 11:30 A.M. on Thanksgiving Day.
