Today, 2/23/2021 we tested all staff and had no positive results for COVID-19.

We are currently having activities for residents. Residents are required to wear a mask at the activity and proper hand hygiene is being practiced along with residents being appropriately social distanced. Dining rooms have also been opened up for use. Residents are able to come to the dining room if they wish for meals and sit one resident per table. We also started offering inside visits again. These will continue as long as we don't have any positive cases in the facility.

Today, we also started beautician services back up. We will be going by units to provide these services. We will start with 3 West and then go to 2 West, 2 East, and Chiara. We will not be doing standing appointments at this time to make sure everybody can receive services. To start off, we will not be having perms or hair coloring until we make sure everybody that wants a haircut gets one. Once everybody receives a haircut we will be able to start offering perms and hair coloring. Residents will be required to wear masks.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
