To Our Residents and Family Members:

Yesterday we tested all staff and had no positive results for COVID-19.

We are currently having activities for residents. Residents are required to wear a mask at the activity and proper hand hygiene is being practiced along with residents being appropriately social distanced. Dining rooms have also been opened up for use. Residents are able to come to the dining room if they wish for meals and sit one resident per table. Beautician services are also up and running.

On 3/29/2021 we implanted new visitation guidelines that have allowed for residents that have been vaccinated to have visitors visit them in their rooms. For residents that have not been vaccinated, we are still following our old visitation guidelines where visitors can come and see them in a designated visitation room that is in front of our receptionist desk.

On Monday 4/5/2021 residents and staff that had not previously received the vaccine had an opportunity to receive the first shot of the Moderna vaccination here at St. Francis. The 2nd dose of the vaccination will be administered on Monday 5/3/2021. At that time, any additional residents and staff that want to receive their first dose of the vaccine will have the opportunity to do so on this date as well.

We are still encouraging family members to connect with their loved ones through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media formats.

We know this continues to be a difficult time for everyone. We will continue to update you as we have updates to give.
